**about the harvest**: Date of harvest: mid-March

Type of harvest: Hand harvest in the cool morning.

**in the cellar** : Method: Cold maceration for 3 days, followed by juice extraction. Pump over and punch down 3 times daily.

Temperature: 16° - 28° C

Length: 10-25 days on skins

Malolactic: In stainless steel tank with wood staves.
