Mediterranean - rainfall 650mm per annum Vineyards situated on northern slopes and at the end of the valley hence slightly warmer conditions.

Soil

Deep red soils. A mixture of weathered granite and a small percentage of clay, Clovelly and Hutton structure.

Vinification/Maturing

Harvesting is done by hand. Fermented with yeast WE 372 at 28°C. Malolactic fermentation took place in stainless steel tanks, then transferred into oak barrels for 18 months.

Tasting Notes

Colour : Deep and concentrated, colour of blackberries, rich in glass.

Aroma : Vanilla, beautiful complexity, with additional melted tones of wild game, blackberry.

Pallet : Full and fruity, touch of toasting, long finish and well balanced.
