about the harvest: Date of Harvest: mid-March
Type of Harvest: Hand harvest in the cool morning.

in the cellar : Method: Cold maceration for 3 days, followed by juice extraction. Pump over and punch down 3 times daily.
Temperature: 16° - 28° C
Length: 10-25 days on skins
Malolactic: In stainless steel tanks with wood staves.
