Veritas 2008 - Silver

in the vineyard : The grapes were sourced from two trellised vineyard blocks located between 5 and 10 km from the cellar. The vines, grafted on to Richter 99 rootstock, are between 10 and 15 years old and grow in clayey, stony soils with irrigation supplied. Both blocks are meticulously managed to ensure full ripeness and the best quality grapes. The grapes for this gentle, muscat-scented, semi-sweet wine were harvested fully ripe to ensure optimal flavour extraction.

about the harvest: The grapes were picked in the coolness of the early morning and kept under cold condition until pressing.

in the cellar : Skin contact was allowed for 24 hours at a temperature of between 10° and 12° C and under a layer of carbon dioxide to protect the juice and skin from oxidation. The free-running juice was then racked and fermented dry over a period of 2 weeks at 12° to 14° C. After stabilisation the wine was filtered before bottling.
