

## McGregor Rosé 2008

Bright light red pink colour emphasizes the youth and freshness of this wine. Prominent ripe banana flavours on palate and bouquet that carry forward in a fresh, long fruity off-dry aftertaste.

Enjoy this young wine with fish soup, delicate smoked fish, barbecued chicken or on its own.

**about the harvest:** Date: Middle February

**in the cellar :** Free-run juice extracted shortly after crushing from the skins. After pre-cooling and settling, it was fermented with select yeast to capture freshness and flavour. After fermentation, a blend of the different cultivars was made.
