

Swartland Shiraz / Malbec 2010

Colour: Deep ruby red colour.

Bouquet: Lots of red berry fruit from Malbec combined with the smokey and spicy flavours of Shiraz.

Palate: The wine has soft tannins and an elegant, lingering aftertaste.

Enjoy with light red meat dishes like seared steak or grilled lamb skewers with bacon and rosemary seasoning.

in the vineyard : Warm, dry summers and cold, wet winters. Limited irrigation, mainly dry land, bush vine vineyards.

about the harvest: These hand harvested grapes are selected by the viticulturist.

in the cellar : Grapes are fermented at 27°C for 3 days and the winemaker allowed for extended skin contact of 3 days.
