This is a Merlot/Pinotage Rose with abundant raspberry flavours and hints of Turkish Delight. The Doolhof Cape Series celebrates several of the unique animals and birds of Southern Africa.

This dry, light Rose, perfect for picnics, was produced from the juice obtained during the process of bleeding of *saignee*. The wine has floral notes and strawberry flavours with a crisp, dry finish.

This wine is an ideal aperitif as well as a perfect picnic partner. Excellent with goat's cheese tartlets of prawn and avocado wraps.
