The grapes were sourced from well-established, premier vineyards in Porterville. The vineyards are all irrigated.

### **about the harvest:**

#### **The winemaking (winemakers: Linley Schultz)**

The grapes were all hand harvested from mid-January and delivered to the cellars at approximately 20°C. They received no skin contact.

**in the cellar** : Fermentation in stainless steel tanks took place at 15°C for a period of 10 days. No malolactic fermentation was induced.
