

Nederburg Foundation Rosé 2008

Colour: Lovely pale red rosé

Bouquet: Soft fruity aromas with an abundance of strawberry.

Palate: A lively light to medium-bodied wine with a clean, fruity and refreshing finish.

The winemaker suggests serving with smoked salmon, summer salads or vegetarian dishes.

variety : Cinsaut | 56% Cinsaut, 17% Cabernet Sauvignon, 12% Merlot, 5% Cabernet Franc, 5% Malbec, 4% Pinotage

in the vineyard : The grapes were sourced from vineyards in the Durbanville and Darling areas. Planted between 1985 and 1995, these vineyards grow in decomposed granite, and are situated between 50 m and 150 m above sea level.

about the harvest: The grapes were harvested by hand between 18° and 19° Balling during mid-February.

in the cellar : They were crushed and received four to six hours of skin contact. Cool-fermentation followed in temperature-controlled stainless steel tanks for two to three weeks at 13°C before being left on fine fermentation lees for at least four weeks.
