The grapes were harvested 1-10 March 1998 and picked at 23° balling. Fermentation of the skins took place for a period of 5 days at $28 \hat{A}^{\circ}\text{C}$. The wine matured for 6 months in 3rd fill French oak barrels.

Tasting Notes

Colour: Purple reflections, youthful vibrance, rich.

Aroma: Violets, crushed fruits (strawberry, rasberry, blackcurrant) and notes spice. Pallet: Succulent, fruit start, spicy and floral underlined by a good alcahol, acidity
