

Seidelberg Un Deux Trois 2006

This is a wine with subtle berry and fruit aromas on the nose, followed by a combination of fruit and structure on the palate. Time has ensured that all the components of the wine are integrated and compliments one another.

in the vineyard : The first grapes of the 2006 vintage were harvested during the middle of January 2006 and the last grapes arrived in the cellar during the last week of March 2006.

in the cellar : SEIDELBERG UDT is a blend of the three Bordeaux Varieties. Traditionally Cabernet Sauvignon provides the backbone and structure, Merlot adds fruit and Cabernet Franc gives finesse and elegance to the wine. The wine matured in 300 liter French Oak barrels for 18 months.
