in the cellar: Hoopenburg Sauvignon Blanc 2000 is dry and unwooded in style, showing a bright, pale straw colour indicating its youth and vibrancy. The nose is fresh and aromatic, with typical varietal fruit scents of pineapple, grenadilla and melon. It is soft, easy on the palate, but with a lively acidity, a combination that makes for a good drinking wine on its own or with food. Enjoy while young, as this is a delicate, rather pungent, powerful Sauvignon Blanc.



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
