

Oak Lane Shiraz 2008

The 2008 Shiraz has been made along the lines of the traditional Rhone style. The wine offers subtle flavours of white pepper and spices complimented by juicy ripe plums and hints of sweet cassis. A well structured wine with its lovely balanced acid and ripe, integrated tannins will drink divinely now and will continue to impress for another 5 years, if cellared correctly. Drinking well now but if cellared will only add to your enjoyment.
