

Beau Joubert Merlot 2004

This is a full bodied red wine, aged for 12 months in small French oak barrels. Tastes of sweet black currant followed by rich flavors of mocha and coffee while the soft ripe integrated tannins and fruit have combined well to create a soft full palate. This wine will aged well for the next 8 years if cellared correctly peaking in the next 2 years. This wine can be drunk now on its own or with most dishes.
