

## Allee Bleue Starlette Rouge 2007

Roasted almonds and ripe cherry fruit abound with savoury notes complementing the smooth mouth-feel. Spiciness from the Shiraz and Pinotage add extra dimension. A smokey nose with layers of cured meats, pepper, nutmeg and cinnamon. Rewarded by an elegant earthy palate with flavours of red currents, herbs, spices and a fresh lingering finish.

Tapas plate of cured meats and pâté served with crispy baguette and gherkins. Cape bobotie with all the trimmings.
