

Allee Bleue Pinotage 2007

A fine and alluring wine with distinct chocolate and raspberry aromas punctuated with roasted nut and liquorice flavours. The lithe tannin structure lends itself to early enjoyment yet promises good ageing potential. Mocca chocolate, cloves, liquorice and blackberries on the nose and palate. A well structured wine with a lingering finish.

Freshly caught snoek oven baked with butter and apricot puree (chilled wine). Springbok loin wrapped in mushrooms and rich homemade puff pastry and sauced with a meaty Pinotage jus.
