

Muratie 1763 Methode Cap Classique 2007

The wine shows crisp apples followed by biscuit flavours. The Pinot Noir supports the Chardonnay by giving the wine a fuller, more rounded structure. Small bubbles and a fine mousse caress the tongue, a great achievement for the first ever Cap Classique on Muratie. The wine dazzles with a gorgeous gold tint.

about the harvest: This MCC is made from a blend of Chardonnay (71%) and Pinot Noir (29%). The grapes were harvested between 18.5° and 19.5° B.
