Beautifully clear with a distinctive green tinge, the wine shows fresh aromas of gooseberry, grass and nettles. a subtle dry, well-rounded palate offers rich flavours of passion fruit and notes reminiscent of grass.

Serve with goat's milk cheese and fresh herb soufflé.

about the harvest: Grapes were harvested from selected vineyard blocks at 23 degrees balling for reductive vinification. After slow, cold fermentation the wine matured for 3 months on the primary lees.
