

Riebeek Pinotage 2007

Bright ruby red with a purple rim, typical of a young Pinotage. Complex flavours of plum and fruitcake are well-integrated with subtle oak to finish with a lingering aftertaste.

An ideal accompaniment to lunchtime barbecues and rare beef.
