Rich cherry, strawberries and plums on the nose with ripe red berry fruit and spicy flavours on the palate. A full structured and well balanced with an elegant mouthfeel and silky soft tannins.

Enjoy with cassoulette, ceps fillet, pasta chingale, cheese curd or gorgonzola cheese.

in the vineyard : Pinotage vineyards planted on granite gravels in Firgrove, Stellenbosch and loamy Table mountain sandstone in Franschhoek. Vineyards produce around 6 - 8 tons per hectare.

in the cellar : Fermented in open and closed fermenters with regular punch downs and pump overs. 12 Months maturation in new (30%), 2nd and 3rd fill French and American oak.
