The color is a lovely, pale yellow. On the nose you will find yoghurt with lemon, lime and vanilla flavours. The palate has a soft foam not aggressive, with a lingering after taste. The lime and green apple give the wine freshness.

in the cellar : This is the first Cap Classique which is made of Pinot Noir and Chardonnay. Previously we made it from Chardonnay and Pinotage. The percentage is 60% Chardonnay and 40% Pinot Noir. Fermented in old Oak barrels and aged for 1 year before bottling and secondary fermentation. The wine was on the lees for 11 months before de-gorging took place.
