

## Diemersdal Sir Lambert Sauvignon Blanc 2009

A crisp, dry and racy Sauvignon Blanc. Flinty at first with fresh green asparagus and a hint of gooseberry filling out the palate. A mouthful of exotic fruit with a perfect acid balance.

A great aperitif. Ideally suited to sushi, shellfish and summer salads.

### in the vineyard : Origin of Grapes

Lambert's Bay, Cape West Coast, South Africa.  
3 kilometers inland from the cold Atlantic Ocean.

**Tons per Hectare:** 6 t/ha

**Age of Vines:** 5 years

**Soils:** Limestone soil

**Trellising:** 4 Wire Perold system

**Irrigation:** Additional micro irrigation

**about the harvest:** Early morning. Harvesting is done by hand.

**in the cellar :** Minimal intervention in the natural process of vinification, allowing the cultivar to express its individual characteristics and the terroir of its origin. After fermentation the lees was stirred up once a week for concentration and mouth-feel.
