

Dornier Cocoa Hill Chenin Blanc 2009

Fresh flavours of pineapple, ripe loquat, peach, nuances of citrus along with the richness due the lees ageing, dominate the wine. A long, clean and crisp tropical fruit aftertaste lingers on the palate accompanied by the contrasting fullness and texture, expressing the true complexity of this variety.
