

Arniston Bay Pinotage Rosé 2009

Bright strawberry hue. Fresh strawberry aromas with a bright citrus nuance. Juicy cherry flavours underpinned by red apple and passion fruit notes. Lengthy close has a red licorice richness.

On its own, or with a platter of oysters and grilled shrimp, it's a vacation in your glass.
