

## Nederburg Foundation Rosé 2009

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Colour: Lovely pale orange rose

Bouquet: Soft fruity aromas with an abundance of strawberry.

Palate: A lively light to medium-bodied wine with a clean, fruity and refreshing finish.

The winemaker suggests serving with smoked salmon, summer salads or vegetarian dishes.

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**variety :** Cabernet Sauvignon | 54% Cabernet Sauvignon, 31% Cinsaut, 7% Merlot, 3% Cabernet Franc, 3% Pinotage, 2% Malbec

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**in the vineyard :** The grapes were sourced from vineyards in the Durbanville and Darling areas. Planted between 1985 and 1995, these vineyards grow in decomposed granite, and are situated between 50 m and 150 m above sea level.

**about the harvest:** The grapes were harvested by hand between 18° and 19° Balling during mid-February.

**in the cellar :** They were crushed and received four to six hours of skin contact. Cool-fermentation followed in temperature-controlled stainless steel tanks for two to three weeks at 13°C before being left on fine fermentation lees for at least four weeks.
