

Kumkani Shiraz / Cabernet Sauvignon 2006

Spice and fruit combined, with a hint of mint from the Cabernet. Complex, yet soft in tannin structure. Medium to full bodied wine, ripe berry and mint supported by well integrated oak aroma with fruit layered palate. Good finish.

This wine complements virtually any meal.
