

Haute Cabrière Chardonnay Pinot Noir 2009

The Haute Cabrière Chardonnay/Pinot Noir has a unique elegance and balance: the Chardonnay contributing elegance, and the Pinot Noir fruit and flavour intensity.

The 2009 vintage is refined, with a firm acidity and an abundance of ripe fruit on the bouquet and palate. The aftertaste lingers long on the palate, a typical characteristic of Cabrière wines.

The slightest pink hue can be discreetly detected in this vintage - this could be dangerously enticing.
