

Allee Bleue Chenin Blanc

This wine displays a pale-yellow colour with slightly greenish tones. The nose is enticed by aromas of pickled pineapple, mature papaya, succulent peaches and apricots as well as a hint of lemongrass. It presents itself on the palate with a fine melting sensation, a powerful structure and magnificent length. Finally, the fruity aromas of the scent are repeated, supplemented by an elegant sourness and a subtle mineral hint.
