

Bouchard Finlayson Sauvignon Blanc Reserve 2009

The Sauvignon blanc grape gets its name from the French *savage* ("wild") but fortunately this cuvee is more aptly described as strikingly elegant with a flinty nose where the palate is crisp and clean with a bright lingering finish.

variety : Sauvignon Blanc | 88% Sauvignon Blanc, 12% Semillon

ageing : Expected to evolve with at least four years maturation in its favour.

in the vineyard : This "Reserve" is a single bottling encouraged by the call for a selection presented to the winemakers at the advent of this particularly fine vintage. A vintage characterized by excellent fruit emanating from a rain free quality summer where every expression lent itself to best opportunity.

in the cellar : The wine enjoys a very small contribution of French oak.
