

Boekenhoutskloof Syrah 2007

The 2007 Syrah shows intense depth of fruit with delicate texture and well-integrated tannins. The nose is explosive with black fruit, raspberries and hints of blossom. A spicy, aromatic profile develops with some age. The elegance and texture of this wine make it extremely accessible at an early stage.

in the vineyard : The Boekenhoutskloof Syrah fruit has been source from a specific site in Wellington for the past 9 years. The SH-21 clone was planted on this SE-facing slope in 1993.

about the harvest: In 2007 the fruit was harvested over a two week period starting on February 21st. The complexity of this wine benefits from the variation in grape maturity from the different harvests
