

Nederburg Foundation Lyric 2010

Colour: Lime green.

Bouquet: Aromas of passion fruit and citrus with hints of freshly-cut grass.

Palate: Crisp and generous with minerality and fresh acidity.

Excellent served on its own or with seafood, light meals and salads.

variety : Sauvignon Blanc | 56% Sauvignon Blanc, 23% Chenin Blanc, 21% Chardonnay

in the vineyard : The grapes were sourced from vineyards in the Durbanville, Stellenbosch and Paarl areas. The vines, situated some 80m to 120m above sea level and planted between 1969 and 1998, are grown in Clovelly, Hutton, Tukulu and Oakleaf soils. The vines are grafted onto nematode-resistant rootstock Richter 99 and 101-14 and vineyard management protocols are followed for optimal grape quality.

about the harvest: The grapes were harvested by hand and machine at 20° to 22° Balling from mid-January until the end of February.

in the cellar : The fruit was crushed, pressed and then settled for 36 hours. The juice was fermented in temperature-controlled stainless steel tanks for a period of three weeks at 15°C after the grapes were racked off the lees. The different components were fermented separately and only blended once fermentation was completed.
