South Africa's first Pinot Noir vines were planted at Muratie way back in 1927, under the supervision of the well-known Professor Perold.

Mature garnet colour. Rich berry fruit combined with earthy forest floor aromas. Elegant and well-balanced palate. Well-integrated oak, long lasting linger.
