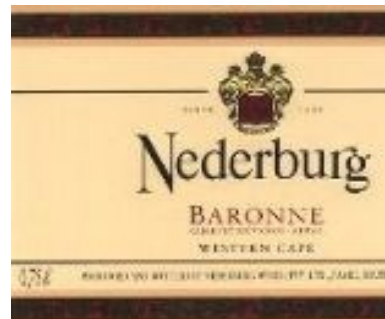

ageing : This is the lighter style of the Nederburg reds and although incredibly accessible when released has great maturation potential of five to seven years.

in the cellar : 50% of the wine was wood matured in large oak vats for 12 months. Baronne is a blend of Cabernet Sauvignon and Shiraz. Blending is the art of bringing together two or more wines from different cultivars, tanks or vintages. This results in uniformity from year to year, creating a specific style of wine and enhancing the final product by bringing together each element with its own outstanding feature, thus creating a masterpiece.
