in the vineyard : The Bertrams Sherry and Port range draws its heritage from when Robert Fuller Bertrams first made wine in the Constantia valley back in the 1800s. The Bertrams company continued to expand until the decision was made to relocate the winery to the Devon Valley in Stellenbosch in 1959. The estate extends over 220 hectares, most situated on gently rising slopes with a prevailing south-east wind that acts like a thermostat on both the vines and the valley. Because of the excellent location, soil types and excellent rainfall, the estate is able to plant the varietals perfect for producing exceptional Port and Sherry.
