BACKGROUND:

The sister wine of the famous Adelberg red blend.

VINTAGE DESCRIPTION:

Winter rains commenced early but by mid winter the rainfall had dropped dramatically resulting in a unusually dry winter. Spring came early but then very cold and rainy weather conditions in November badly affected certain grapes. Cool December conditions resulted in a later than expected start to the vintage. Shortly thereafter the temperatures soared and sugar levels rose, producing very healthy, plump ripe berries.
