

Allee Bleue Starlette Blanc 2009

A lovely bright colour with a touch of green. Hints of green pepper followed by layers of tropical fruit welcome you on the nose. The palate is fresh and lively packed with flavours of passion fruit and mango while the perfect balance between sugar and acidity give this wine an elegant, zesty aftertaste.

Enjoy with a cool summer salad. Bruschetta with tomato pesto and classic, crisp coss lettuce, anchovies, coddled egg and parmesan cheese.
