

The Den Cabernet Sauvignon 2009

A juicy fruit packed smooth wine with aromas of blackcurrants, blackberry and vanilla, and soft juicy black fruit flavors. The wine has a lovely silky texture and a long smooth finish.

This Cabernet Sauvignon is really delicious with home cooked South African meals such as a sweet and spicy bobotie, beef burgers off the braai with sweet tangy bbq sauce or wors, pap and chakalaka.
