about the harvest: The grapes were harvested by hand early in the morning

Yield: 6t/ha

in the cellar : Minimal intervention in the natural process of vinification, allowing the cultivar to express its individual characteristics and the terroir of its origin.

Traditional punch-downs every 4 hours during fermentation, 16 months 75% new French oak maturation.
