

Klein Steenberg Rosé 2009

This light rosé is a fresh, dry wine, full of red and black berry flavour, with hints rose water and spice. This wine should be enjoyed in its youth and is ideal as a refreshing summer wine or aperitif.

Enjoy this wine as a refreshing summer wine, aperitif, or to accompany Bouillabaise or delicious seafood bisques.

in the vineyard : This blend always consists of a minimum of 85% Sauvignon Blanc sourced from Paarl, Franschoek and Constantia.

about the harvest: It is a blend of Cabernet Sauvignon, Shiraz and Merlot. The red grapes were specifically picked for rosé.

in the cellar : On arriving at the cellar they were crushed, de-stemmed and left to soak overnight before being pressed. This extracted the wonderful red-pink colour of the wine. The juice was fermented with a white wine yeast in stainless steel at 13° C resulting in fresh, racy red and black berry fruit characters developing along with hints of mint and cloves.
