

## Le Bonheur Cabernet Sauvignon 1995

Sakkie Kotze desribes the nose as rich and lively blackcurrent flavours. It is medium to full bodied with blackberry flavours in the month.

The wine won a Veritas Double Gold Medal in 1998.

in the vineyard: The Cabernet Sauvignon vines are situated between 200 and 350 metres above seal level. It faces north and north east and was planted between 1973 and 1986

about the harvest: The grapes were picked by hand at 22,5° to 23.5°Balling from 13 to 27 March. The yield was 4 tons per hectare.

in the cellar: The juice fermented on the skins at  $25 {\rm \AA^o}$  to  $30 {\rm \AA^o}$ C for 7 days. The wine was withdrawn from the skins 10 days after fermentation. After malolactic fermentation the wine was wood matured for 18 months - 50% in new casks and the rest in second-fill casks.



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
