

Muratie Cabernet Sauvignon 2007

Colour: Deep ruby with intense centre.

Nose: Violets and mint mixed with layers of berries and hints of cedar-wood and cassis.

Palate: Great balance and integration of fruit and oak. The wine has a strong mid-palate and offers a full, lingering aftertaste.

about the harvest: The grapes were handpicked yielding 6 tons per hectare.
