

Aaldering Vineyards & Wines Cabernet Sauvignon / Merlot 2007

A round and juicy wine which stirs taste notes of strawberry, blackberry, and plums. A full-bodied red wine with a balance of red and black fruit that leaves a tinge of dark chocolate at the finish.

ageing : Enjoy right now or age up to 6 years if you can resist the temptation to open this bottle.

in the vineyard : The 1.32 hectares of Merlot vineyards and the 2.39 hectares of Cabernet Sauvignon vineyards have a rich red hutton and clovelly soil. The grapes were picked from 12 year old vines.

about the harvest : The two varieties were harvested separately at their optimum ripeness. The grapes were hand-picked and taken to the winery in small bins where only the best quality grapes were selected for the winemaking process.
