

Hamilton Russell Vineyards Pinot Noir 2009

Our low-vigour, stony, clay-rich soil, cool maritime mesoclimate, naturally tiny yields of under 30 hl/ha and our philosophy of expressing our terroir in our wines - give rise to a certain tightness, tannin line and elevated length to balance the richness and generosity of our Pinot noir.

Our Pinot noir is not overtly fruity, soft and "sweet" but shows hints of that alluring savoury "primal" character along with a dark, spicy, complex primary fruit perfume. Estate Wine of Origin Hemel-en-Aarde Valley.
