in the cellar : After destemming bunches, grapes were slowly fermented in open and closed fermenters. It was then further matured in new French oak barrels. 35% new French oak barrels and of the 65% remaining, half was fermented in American oak barrels. Fining, with the use of egg white and gentle sheet secretion occurred prior to bottling.
