

Bay View Sauvignon Blanc 2000

Crisp acids with citrus and grassy flavors, rounded off by a lingering finish. Balanced and complex with a lively, youthful mouthfeel.

in the vineyard : Through good vineyard management we managed to get grapes off in time to maintain some good structure and flavour.

in the cellar : Grapes were destemmed and crushed, given 3 to 4 hours skin contact and thereafter fermented in stainless steel tanks. The wine was made reductively, excluding as much air as possible during the winemaking process in order to retain substantial fruit flavours. Prior to bottling, the wine was gently fined and filtered.
