

## Edgebaston "The Berry Box" 2009

A medley of small berry and fruit flavours including blackcurrant, raspberry, strawberry, mulberry and blackberry combine with a hint of anise and vanilla to give a wine that is instantly gratifying in flavour whilst showing good structure and tannin concentration to allow for some maturation.

The resultant, soft tannins and berry flavours have been blended to compose a modern, fruit driven wine with class.

Wood Elevation:

20% 1st Fill New French Oak – Nevers, Allier; Medium Toasted

50% 2nd Fill French Oak – Medium Toasted

30% 3rd Fill French Oak

Bottled under screwcap to ensure quality.
