

## Jacob's Quest "Rite of Passage" Cabernet Sauvignon 2009

Colour: Dark ruby red

Bouquet: Dark red fruit, chocolate and berry flavours.

Taste: Complex with well balanced tannins and a lingering finish.

Jacob Peu recommends this wine for relaxed moments, soul food and gatherings with friends.

**variety** : Cabernet Sauvignon | 100% Cabernet Sauvignon

**winery** : Jakob's Vineyards

**winemaker** : Dico du toit

**wine of origin** : Swartland

**analysis** : alc : 14.5 % vol   rs : 4.1 g/l   pH : 3.41   ta : 5.7 g/l

**type** : Red

**pack** : Bottle   **closure** : Screwcap

**in the vineyard** : Grown at the foot of the Great Winterhoek Mountains, around the town of Porterville in the Swartland Region.

**about the harvest**: The grapes were harvested at between 24.5° and 26° Balling. Two vineyard blocks were cold soaked separately for two days.

**in the cellar** : Each of the two batches of Cabernet Sauvignon were fermented with a different yeast at 22°C (cool ferment) for seven days to retain fruit flavours. After malolactic fermentation the wine was blended and aged in 3rd and 4th fill French Oak barrels for a period of 9 months.
