Sunset pink in colour. Refreshing Pinotage candy (candy floss) nose with hints of strawberries. Well balanced well balanced that picks up the full ripe strawberry flavours with a lingering after taste.

in the vineyard : Trellised vines aged 8 – 15 years planted yielded the grapes for this wine. The vineyards received supplementary drip irrigation and produced 8 - 15 tons per hectare.

about the harvest:

Breedekloof Grapes were healthy and showed signs of physiological ripeness at lower sugar content. The harvest here was much earlier than usual.

Swartland / Malmesbury - the old adage that a light wheat crop precedes a light grape crop, appears to hold true for the 2010 harvest. Grape analyses were generally good and practically all the white grapes were crushed before the March heat wave.

Coastal Region - cooler conditions resulted in wines with good fruit and great body. Winemakers enthuse about phenolic ripeness, finesse and structure.
