

## Topiary Rose 2009

Light salmon in colour, with aromas of strawberry and confectionary. Clean and dry on the palate.

variety: Shiraz | 50% Shiraz, 50% Cabernet Sauvignon winery: Topiary Wines winemaker: Chris Albrecht wine of origin: Franschhoek analysis: alc:13.4 % vol rs:6 g/l pH:3.14 ta:6 g/l va:0.32 g/l type:Rose wooded pack:Bottle closure:Screwcap

in the vineyard : A lot of attention is paid to detail in the vineyards regarding canopy management.

**about the harvest:** Harvested from mature and trellised vines at a ripeness of 22°B. Harvesting was done early in the morning by hand followed by rigorous sorting.

**in the cellar**: Selected batches of Shiraz and Cabernet Sauvignon (50:50) were drained and co-fermented with St George yeast. Kept on gross lees in tank for three months and stirred regularly. Partially completed malo-lactic fermentation. 20% Matured in old wood.
