

Topiary Blanc de Blanc MCC 2009

Refreshing green apple and quince with lingering yeastiness. Crisp and traditional, yet rich and balanced finish.

in the vineyard : A lot of attention is paid to detail in the vineyards regarding canopy management.

about the harvest: Harvested from mature and trellised vines at a ripeness of 18.5 °B. Harvesting was done early in the morning by hand followed by rigorous sorting.

in the cellar : The grapes were whole-bunch pressed and settled for 24 hours, after which it was inoculated with N96 for primary fermentation. Malolactic fermentation was induced and the wine spent six months on the primary gross lees. Bottled in August 2009, the wine spent 15 months on the secondary lees. Disgorged in December 2010 and released four months later.
